GARY MILLER & THE VOLUNTEERS: 'Reflections on War' Tour 2011

Towards the end of 2010, internationally renowned songwriter, performer and recording artist Gary Miller released the highly acclaimed 'Reflections on War', his ground-breaking debut solo album and first CD of all new material in 10 years, a landmark release for this persevering and innovative artist which successfully relaunched his fulltime recording and performing career after a long period "in the wilderness" through illness.

Produced by award-winning producer, songwriter and musician Iain Petrie, the 10-track CD (catalogue number WPTCD22) is the 22nd release on Miller's own international label Whippet Records and features songs commissioned as part of a major exhibition at York Art Gallery on the theme of war entitled 'Reflections on War'.

Now, the official 'Reflections on War' Tour prepares to hit the road in 2011 for one time only...

Gary Miller and Iain Petrie have collaborated in carefully put together a unique line-up of high-pedigree musicians to accompany them, including members of Iain's own band The Gypsy Soul Experience as well as musicians from the album sessions, to perform an exclusive live show of 'Reflections on War' for a limited time only. This will be a strictly one-off tour and therefore a unique and never to be repeated opportunity for promoters to book, and for audiences to experience, what promises to be a stunning live event.

'Gary Miller & The Volunteers' will be providing a full evening of high entertainment that dramatically brings to life the stories of the project through the performance of the songs to a stunning visual backdrop of photographs, artwork and archive film. A 2-hour set is promised, featuring all 10 songs from the CD plus a selection of additional songs that relate specifically to the project and its theme of war (including some written specially for the project but not included on the CD), subtly interspersed with selections of poetry and war-themed recollections from the project, which serve to further enhance these fascinating and thought-provoking stories.

The nucleus of 'Gary Miller & The Volunteers' features:

GARY MILLER - Vocals, Acoustic Guitar, Mandolin

IAIN PETRIE - Electric & Acoustic Guitars, Bass, Vocals

ALI PETRIE - Keyboards, Piano, Vocals

ALLAN CRANSTON - Drums, Percussion

Gary Miller first rose to international prominence during the mid-Eighties and throughout the Nineties as principal songwriter, lead singer, guitarist & mandolin player with The Whisky Priests (1985-2002), the internationally renowned folk-rock band with a worldwide cult following that he founded and fronted with his twin brother Glenn - *"the Joe Strummer and Mick Jones of the Folk World"*. The Whisky Priests released a string of internationally acclaimed albums but were particularly recognised worldwide for their incredible live shows: *"A Whisky Priests show is the sort of stuff to make your hair curl; honest, earthy, loud, raucous and tremendously uplifting"* (Folk Roots, UK).
